How to Find the Eastgate Cottages At Levisham

To Pickering

From the South take the A1 or M1 north until you reach the A64. If you using the M1 then after the M62 you will pick up the new M1 link road that connects to the A1 just before the A64.

From the West get off the M62 at the M1 intersection and head towards Leeds but immediately pick up the new A1 link road that will take you to the A64.

Follow the signs to York taking the slip road off the A1 to the A64. Continue on the A64 past York and toward Scarborough. It's about half an hour drive from the A1 to the Pickering turnoff. (traffic permitting). Turn off the A64 onto the A169 at the junction signposted Pickering and follow the road for about 6 miles until you enter Pickering. In Pickering, continue on until you reach the roundabout and go straight across towards Whitby.

From the North or North West there are a variety of routes but the main one is probably through Thirsk, up Sutton Bank (which is very steep) and on through Helmsley (A170). It is not the fastest route in the world but it is very pretty with plenty of interesting places to break the journey. This brings you into the east of Pickering. In Pickering, continue on until you reach the roundabout and turn left towards Whitby.

From Scarborough Following signs for Pickering you will go through Thornton-le-dale (ice cream shop on the right hand side) and continue on towards Pickering. In Pickering, continue on until you reach the roundabout (you will pass Eastgate Cottages on the left) and turn right towards Whitby.

From Pickering

Carry on towards Whitby for approx 6 miles (about a ½ mile past the Fox & Rabbit pub you will see a turn off to your left signposted 'Lockton' and 'Levisham' (next to the cricket pitch)

Drive through Lockton, bearing right to Levisham. At this point you go up and down a 1 in 5 hill, oh and there is a couple of very tight bends – Now you should be in Levisham. Carry straight on to the end of the village and past the pub on your right..... only two miles to go. Following the signs to Levisham Station, at the bottom of the hill, just before the cattle grid turn left into the cottages. The cottages are on the right and you can park opposite them.

For those of you with Satellite navigation our address is; Grove House, Levisham Station, Pickering, YO18 7NN

Arrival Time

We have to clean the cottage on a Saturday so they are available from 2pm, sometimes they are ready earlier but I can't guarantee it. If you are planning to arrive earlier then let us know and we will give priority to servicing cottage. Similarly if you plan to arrive after 6pm let us know so we can arrange to meet you at the cottage.
