How to Find Rye Cottage, Marton

From the South take the A1 or M1 north until you reach the A64. If you are using the M1 then after the M62 junction you will pick up the new M1 link road that connects to the A1 just before the A64 junction.



From the West get off the M62 at the M1 intersection and head towards Leeds. Immediately pick up the new A1 link road that will take you to the A64.

Follow the signs to York taking the slip road off the A1 to the A64 (York).

Continue on the A64 York ring road toward Scarborough. It's about 40 minutes drive from the A1 to the Pickering turn off. (traffic permitting). Turn off the A64 at the A169 junction signposted Pickering and follow the road for about 6 miles.

As you enter Pickering you will reach a roundabout, turn left towards Helmsley/Thirsk (A170). Travel about 3 miles passing through the villages of Middleton, Aislaby and Wreton, then turn left onto Marton Road (Signposted Marton 1 1/2 miles). On entering the village of Marton the cottage is in Wildsmith Court which is the 2nd right before the sharp left hand bend

From the North or North West there are a variety of routes but the main one is probably through Thirsk, up Sutton Bank (which is very steep) and on through Helmsley (A170). It is not the fastest route in the world but it is very pretty with plenty of interesting places to break the journey. After Kirkbymoorside stay on the A170 for approx 3 miles, as you pass Sinnington take the right turn onto Marton Road (Signposted Marton 1 1/2 miles). On entering the village of Marton the cottage is in Wildsmith Court which is the 2nd right before the sharp left hand bend.

From Scarborough Following signs for Helmsley, through Thornton-le-dale (good ice cream shop on the right hand side) and continue through to Pickering. As you enter Pickering you will reach a roundabout, take the second exit towards Helmsley/Thirsk (A170). Travel about 3 miles passing through the villages of Middleton, Aislaby and Wreton, then turn left onto Marton Road (Signposted Marton 1 1/2 miles). On entering the village of Marton the cottage is in Wildsmith Court which is the 2nd right before the sharp left hand bend.

Rye Cottage In Marton the cottage is within Wildsmith court second house on the left hand side.

For those of you with Satellite navigation the address is; Rye Cottage, 2 Wildsmith Court, Marton, Sinnington, York, YO62 6RD.
